Office on Missing Persons (OMP) Invitation for Proposals – Database Management System Development

The Office on Missing Persons (OMP), under the Ministry of Justice, Sri Lanka, is mandated to trace, document, and manage information relating to missing persons. To strengthen its operational capacity and ensure secure, efficient data handling, the OMP intends to develop a web based comprehensive Database Management System (DBMS). This system will serve as a central repository for case records, facilitate advanced data analysis, and enhance transparency in reporting.

OMP hereby invites proposals from qualified vendors to undertake the design, development, and maintenance of this Database Management System.

Eligibility Criteria for Vendors

- **Company or institution Establishment:** The company must have been in continuous operation for at least seven (07) years.
- **Project Experience:** Must have successfully completed a minimum of five (05) projects in the past, each valued between LKR 5 million and LKR 50 million.
- **Government/Institutional Experience:** Demonstrated experience in government or similar large-scale projects.
- **Annual Maintenance:** The selected vendor must undertake annual maintenance of the system.
- **Permanent Staff:** The company must employ a minimum of five (05) permanent staff members, who should be nominated for this project.
- **No Outsourcing:** Third-party outsourcing is strictly prohibited.
- **No Freelancers:** This project is not open to individual freelancers.
- **Business Registration:** Must hold a valid business registration.
- **Audited Financials:** Submission of audited financial statements for the past three (03) years is required.

- **Confidentiality:** Should accept the non-disclosure agreement in order to ensure the privacy and confidentiality.
